METHODOLOGY, SAMPLE FRAME AND DATA COLLECTION TECHNIQUES

This survey was conducted by Susquehanna Polling and Research¹ in conjunction with media sponsor WHTM-TV/ABC27. Interviews were conducted May 4-8, 2018 with registered Republican likely voters in Pennsylvania. To be eligible for the survey, respondents had to first confirm their strong likelihood to vote in the upcoming Primary Election on Tuesday, May 15.

¹ Susquehanna Polling and Research is a survey research and polling firm representing corporate and political clients in PA, NY, NJ, MD, IN, FL, NC, SC and other states. SP&R's polling has been featured on many national platforms including the Rush Limbaugh Radio Show, FOX News Channel, the Bill Maher Show and MSNBC. The internet news service *Sunshine State News* of Florida referred to SP&R as "one of the most prominent pollsters in the country" for its accurate polling in the 2010 Florida Gubernatorial Republican Primary. WHTM-TV/ABC27 News in Harrisburg recognized SP&R for its accurate polling in the 2016 POTUS election.

The sample frame was constructed using commercially acquired telephone lists from list vendors constituting a representative sample of counties and Republican voters in Pennsylvania. Vote history universe included Republican households with prior vote history in one or better of P14, P15, P16 and/or G15 plus new registrants. Telephone interviews were conducted via automated telephone technology where respondents are asked to record their selections using their telephone key pads by responding to a series of questions in a pre-recorded voice. Automated telephone interviews minimize survey response bias by allowing all respondents to hear the identical questions in the same exact manner, voice inflection and sequence and without inadvertent bias sometimes created from human telephone agents. Only landline telephone interviews were conducted, so results can only be generalized to the population of Republican households with landline telephones.

The margin of error for a sample size of 545 interviews is +/-4.2% at the 95% confidence level.
